**DAY 1 WINNIPEG – MINNEAPOLIS, MN** Today, we will be heading south for a country music lover's dream vacation.

**DAY 2 MINNEAPOLIS – CHAMPAIGN, IL** Travel from Minnesota through Wisconsin's Dairyland, to our overnight lodging in Champaign.

**DAY 3 CHAMPAIGN – PIGEON FORGE, TN (3 NIGHTS)** This morning, we continue our journey through Indiana and Kentucky to the Smoky Mountains.

**DAY 4-5 PIGEON FORGE** A full day of fun awaits us at **Dollywood!** This theme park brings to life the folklore of the Smoky Mountains. Tour the Dolly Parton Chasing Rainbows Museum in Dollywood. On our **Great Smoky Mountains National Park** tour, we will visit Clingmans Dome, where you can put each foot in a different state.
